Forgiveness & Restoration

Being a Christian is not easy.

...even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. Colossians 3:13

The legal system of the United States recognizes there is a time for forgiveness and restoration. A district court ruled a company had mistreated an employee by firing him for alcohol-related misbehavior which took place before his received treatment. The judge decided the man should have been forgiven for the wrong he had committed before he got help and holding pretreatment transgressions against him violated the spirit of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.

The "Rehabilitation Act of A.D. 33" calls for even more mercy. Jesus died on the cross for the sins of humanity, God offers complete forgiveness to repentant sinners. According to Colossians 3:13, Christians should never hold confessed sins against a fellow believer. We are to restore one another in the same way God restores us to Himself. If a brother or sister in Christ wants to be restored from a spiritual "injury," we should doctor and nurse that one back to health. Even if the confessed "wound" is a serious one, we must not leave the person unattended. We must accept a repentant believer by forgiving him, while being careful not to let him drown in tears of regret.

Are we known for showing mercy?

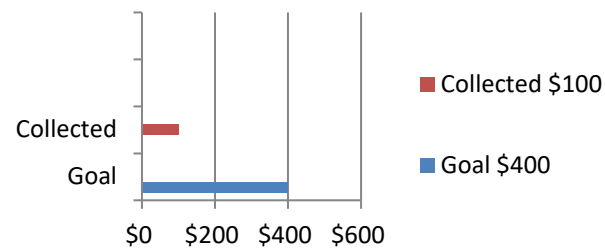

We look forward to seeing familiar faces and worshipping together again. Your safety is our first priority. We feel taking slow and steady steps is the best strategy at this time.

Entry and exit doors will be clearly labeled to avoid confusion. There will be two touchless hand sanitizers placed in Fellowship Hall. Be aware the government is recommending a solution of 70-80% alcohol to kill the virus. In practical terms, this means the hand cleaner coming out of our machines will be in a more liquid form than you may be used to. It will not have any additional scent and will smell like pure alcohol. This is what the government is recommending in terms of alcohol content, so this is what the church will have to ensure your safety. If you get alcohol on your clothes, it will likely stain. Please use with caution.
