God Stands By You & Understands

Philippians 3:1-4:1

There is a wide spectrum of beliefs and hopes by parishioners about how the church should meet their needs for belonging. It would seem this need for belonging is a challenging issue in our current society. People seek to belong in groups demonstrating identity and quality. They expect to be part of a group which upholds important values, while making people feel warmly received. When they are securely connected to others they care about, they are able to identify and affiliate with others of diverse backgrounds and beliefs.

In an election year, voters seek to belong by means of party affiliation. But, at what price comes with a political party affiliation? This is how George Washing spoke about political parties in his farewell address to his Cabinet on September 17, 1766.

The alternate domination of one faction over another, sharpened by the spirit of revenge natural to party dissension, which is different ages and countries has perpetrated the most horrid enormities, is itself a frightful despotism. But this leads at length to a more formal and permanent despotism. The disorders and miseries which result gradually incline the minds of men to seek security and repose in the absolute power of an individual, and sooner or later the chief of some prevailing faction, more able or more fortunate than his competitors, turns this disposition to the purposes of his own elevation on the ruins of public liberty...

Social activist groups historical fragment into smaller segments becoming more radicalized in their stand against authorities of any kind or whatever the cause of the moment might be with the aim of increasingly freeing people from the barriers which limit the full experiences of life. Instead, they may become the tyrants they sought to overthrow.

So, what does the church have to offer in these unusual times? The Apostle Paul put it this way – Let Christ be with you and in you. The church must constantly understand the relationship needs of its parishioners without stepping into an orientation or a daily routine which speaks only to the mind and not the heart of individuals. We must constantly (1) broaden our understanding of what is needed in human relationships; (2) remind ourselves how we can dimmish, if not lose, the human touch within our congregation; and (3) consider altered ways of making relationships.

Last of all, how is your personal relationship with God? How can you broaden your spiritual depth and relationship with God? In what ways has your relationship with God changed you over time? It would seem God walks with you through life. During challenging times, always keep God in Christ with you and within you. You now belong to Christ. Amen.
