

Copyright Issues in Digital Ministry

This article is made possible through the church's continuing educational fund for your pastor and the help and support from Ivy Basinger, our church administrative assistant.

Copyright issues are now part of the weekly preparation for our worship services and other church sponsored activities. At present your pastor and the church administrative assistant have a general knowledge about copyright issues. However, training needs to take place making it a team effort with a larger group of people aware of copyright infringement issues. Failure to be knowledgeable about copyright issues will not prevent the church from being fined.

To help the church manage our use of copyrighted and non-copyrighted material during our worship service only, we subscribe to an organization called CCLI. CCLI makes copyright easy. With a Church Copyright License, we are covered for the copying activities listed below:

1. Storing Lyrics

Enter and store song lyrics on any computer for visual projection to assist congregational singing

2. Printing Songs

Print songs, hymns and lyrics in bulletins or programs for congregational singing

3. Recording Services

Record and capture your worship services (audio and video), provided you only are recording live music

If we were to broadcast a movie or video segment during worship, we would need additional copyrighted permission.

As the choir prepares for our Christmas and Easter Cantatas there are several ways to deal with copyrighted material. You may purchase a song book and CD for all choir members or you may purchase a Rehearsal License. A Rehearsal License provides for the following:

1. Permitted Activities

- Stream (digitally transmit, retransmit, distribute and playback) Recordings in audio and/or video form
- Download (digitally distribute) Recordings such that the audio part can be captured, saved and stored on a personal computer or similar data device for play back
- Make physical copies of recordings and distribute them on a CD, flash drive or similar device





Our church's apostle build day is scheduled for Saturday, December 4, 2021.





Methodist Mountain Mission History

Over 70 years ago a vision of God was planted in the mind of a young minister, Rev. John Lewis, for a mission among the mountain people of Eastern Kentucky. In 1943 this vision was realized and had its beginning under the leadership of Rev. Lewis. He was a pastor in the Methodist Church in Jackson, Kentucky at the time. Rev. Lewis had served two charges in the mountains of Eastern Kentucky during the previous 10 years. He could see the need of the people. He observed the work of Save the Children Federation stores in the area and felt that people of the Methodist churches throughout Kentucky could serve their own people's needs in a similar way. This vision of ministry given to Rev. Lewis had among its purposes to:

- Make available to the people of the area good usable clothing and household items, moderately priced, which the residents of the area can affordably obtain. The philosophy of the Mission has been that it is better to charge a moderate price than to give the items away, as sometimes a gift of such is demeaning. Being able to pay a small price for the merchandise reflects pride of ownership. The income received from the sale of the used clothing and other goods is used to support the mission, pay the wages of the employees, and supplement the salaries of the ministers in the two parish churches.
- Provide a source of employment for the people of the area. The Mission currently supports and provides such employment to 70 families.
- Be involved in the spiritual growth of the people in the community through the financial support of two local United Methodist churches. Currently, the two churches under the Mission are Hampton UMC and Wolverine UMC, both located in Breathitt County.

Now, 70 years later, those purposes have been successfully realized and still are being continued. God made it possible; the people of God took up the cross and have followed Jesus' calling.
