# LaMont's Lines August 2021

#### The Power of Music

The Bible does not say much about music, in the New Testament. It does talk about our emotional lives in some of the Psalms. You find expressions of pain in Psalm 137. The psalmist is one who is part of a group of Israelites exiled from their home, as a result of Babylonian destruction of the state of Israel. The psalm is a lament, a cry of anguish. "By the rivers of Babylon - there we sat down and there we wept" (v. 1). "On the willows there, we hung up our harps" (v. 2). We are not going to "sing the Lord's song in a foreign land" (v. 4). This psalm was an emotional response to their exile.

Psalm 138 speaks of giving God thanks with one's "whole heart" (v. 1), in part because God has increased their "strength of soul" (v. 3). In verse 5, there is a reference to singing "of the ways of the Lord". Music, poetry, and these Psalms help express what one feels from one's heart. This may include direct thanksgiving and expressions of joy. Or even pain, fear and expressions of anger. With the genuine expressions which come from our heart, God uses these emotions to strengthen our souls (v. 3). The psalmist trusts God. God regards the lowly and perceives the haughty from far away (v. 6). The psalmist trusts God in life as it currently exists, "though I walk in the midst of trouble" (v. 7).

A third text, from Colossians 3:16, speaks of music as praise. As part of Paul's outline of a Christian way of life, he includes an admonition- "With gratitude in your hearts sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs to God".

Music's ability to heal in contemporary times after World War I and World War II became apparent when community musicians, both amateur and professional, went to Veteran's hospitals around the country to play for veterans suffering from both physical and emotional traumas of war. The patient's notable physical and emotional responses to music led doctors and nurses to request the hiring of musicians for their patients.
